Thank you for your Freedom of Information request dated 18th August 2009 relating to changes in project expenditure resulting from the cuts affecting SEEDA's 2009-2011 budget plans.

Original Request

Please provide full details of the list of 20 'terminated or deferred projects' resulting from the cuts affecting SEEDA's 2009-11 budget plans.

Revised request following clarification

You clarified this request in terms of the details to be provided as follows:

By "full details" I mean:

- *the names of the projects and a brief summary of each project*
- *the reason for termination or deferral of each project*
- *where the funding for each project came from*
- *how much had been spent if the projects they had started*
- *how much had been allocated to the remainder of the projects if they had started or to the whole of the projects if they had not started*

Information Requested

I am writing to advise you that that the information you requested, a list of terminated or deferred projects resulting from the cuts affecting SEEDA's 2009-11 budget plans, is not held by SEEDA.
